



What is the SBC-BND Summer Media Camp?



Now in its second year, the BND Institute of Media and Culture's 2019 Summer Media Camp combines journalism and multi-platform media technology for students in **grades 8 through 12** to create and display their work via an online presence. The camp is led by Bonnie Newman Davis, who has more than 35 years experience as a newspaper and online journalist and university professor. One of this year's camps will take place **July 29 – August 2 at Second Baptist Church, 1400 Idlewood Ave., Richmond, Va. 23220**. The day begins at 9 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m. The cost is \$50 for the one-week program and some scholarships are available. **The registration deadline is June 30, 2019.**



During the camp, students will build their confidence as they learn about media literacy and sharpen their writing, editing, photography and video skills. Students will work with professional media writers, editors, videographers and special guests who will lead them through aspects of digital storytelling. Fun field trips will further enhance students' learning experience!
